- These Restricted Stock Units, which were awarded on April 27, 2020 pursuant to the Issuer's 2017 Long-Term Incentive Plan, vest ratably on April 27, 2021, March 23, 2022 and March 23, 2023 and were settled in shares of the Issuer's common stock on a one-for-one basis.
- Each Restricted Stock Unit, awarded pursuant to Issuer's 2017 Long-Term Incentive Plan, represents a contingent right to receive one share of the Issuer's common stock. The Restricted Stock Units vest ratably over three years beginning on the first anniversary of the grant date.
